

# Delaware's World War II Fallen List

Compiled by Lowell Silverman

Last updated April 2, 2026 (Version 2.2)

This is a list of 785 known Delawareans who died in the service between December 7, 1941, and September 2, 1945. Men who died after that timeframe but as a direct result of wounds or injuries incurred during that timeframe are also included. This is the most accurate list ever compiled for the state. A hyperlink indicates that there is a completed article for that servicemember on the site.

The definition of Delawarean is “anyone who called Delaware home.” As a result, this list includes some names omitted from previous lists published by the State of Delaware Public Archives Commission and Russ Pickett, including some men who lived in Delaware very briefly but who entered the service there. I erred on the side of including men in a handful of cases where their status was unclear. This list also excludes some names—published on previous lists—for men who never lived in Delaware, but who had family that lived there during the war.

Fields in this version of the database include grade (“rank”), full name (sometimes only middle initial due to space limitations), branch, status (appended with a \* when the situation is complicated) and last unit. By drawing on previously unpublished contemporary records, I was often able to determine a man’s unit down to the company level, a level of detail no previous list of fallen Delawareans has provided. Why only these five fields? I believe these are the most crucial, and the ones that, with a few exceptions, are unlikely to need updating. I also sought to make a simple list that would be easy to browse, with (mostly) one line per person. My working database also includes service number, theater, dates of birth and death, and other fields of varying completeness. When this data is finalized, I hope to release a more detailed version of this list.

## **Status**

Statuses are listed based on official U.S. Army and Marine Corps casualty lists. In some cases, it's complicated, with an asterisk denoting that the official status may be incorrect. Navy and Coast Guard statuses were not recorded in the official casualty lists but I reconstructed them from the circumstances, when known.

The statuses are generally self-explanatory, except FOD: Finding of Death. This indicates that the man was initially missing in action but that after a minimum a year and a day with no credible evidence that the person survived, he was officially declared dead. That period was sometimes extended, especially in the Pacific Theater, where the Japanese did not always report that they had captured American servicemen in timely fashion. Had the soldier not been missing, they would have had a status of KIA or DNB. Although not an official status, when available, I've appended that, resulting in FOD/KIA and FOD/DNB.

Under U.S. Army policy, a man was considered K.I.A. if they died during a combat mission even if the crash was not caused by the enemy. Similarly, a soldier who drowned during an amphibious operation was considered K.I.A. even if the sinking was not due to enemy action. Prisoners of war who were accidentally killed by Allied attacks upon enemy targets also had a status of K.I.A. Air crew who died in crashes during training or transport had a status of D.N.B.)
